

NOTES ON SAFETY

The lowest base position is the safest and should be used as soon as your baby is able to sit up.

When your child is able to climb out or reaches 18 Kg (40lbs) **STOP USING THE COT.**

Use the correct size of mattress as specified.

Remove any cot mobiles when your child is able to sit up.

You may clean the cot with a clean cloth or duster. Do not use abrasives or household polishes.

Regularly check that all bolts and fastenings are tight as a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (eg Strings, necklaces, ribbons for dummies) that would pose a risk of strangulation.

Keep the cot away from sources of strong heat such as open fires, electric fires, gas heaters etc.

DO NOT use plastic bags as mattress covers as these can cause suffocation. If parts are missing or broken **DO NOT** substitute parts. **ALWAYS** obtain new correct parts.

DO NOT place the cot near a window where cords for blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

DO NOT place cords, straps or similar items that could become entangled around a child's neck in or near the cot.

DO NOT leave articles in the cot that could present a risk of strangulation or suffocation.

DO NOT leave articles in the cot which could provide a foothold.

NOTE. THE SAFETY OF THIS COT MAY BE ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY ADDING FLAMMABLE DRAPES.
